

Tips to help find a water leak:

- A large percent of excess water usage is the toilet. If the valve does not properly seal, the water will leak out to a certain level and then fill up again, this is constant water flow.
An easy way to check for this problem is to remove the lid on the water tank, put food coloring in the tank. With out flushing the toilet for several hours, if this colored water appears in the toilet bowl, the valve is not properly sealing.
- Check for leaks around the base of the toilet
- Check for any faucets that have drips or will not shut off all the way
- A water softener could possibly get stuck in the regenerating cycle.
- Check the hot water heater for small leaks.
- If all water supply is turned off inside the house and the leak indicator is moving on the meter, there could be a leak in the water line from the meter to the house.
- The leak indicator is either a triangle or an arrow on the water meter.
- Check for broken water pipes, due to freezing, etc.
- Check for wet spots in the yard.
