

The Board of Trustees of the Town of Fort Branch, Indiana, met at the usual meeting place of the Board in said Town on the 3rd day of ~~August~~^{September}, 1941, at the hour of 7:30 P.M. in ~~special~~^{regular} session at which there was present Trustees Gwaltney, Meyer, and Berlien and Trustee Berlien introduced an ordinance entitled:

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE KEEPING OF HOGS OR PIGS WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF FORT BRANCH, INDIANA, AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

Trustee Berlien moved that the Clerk-Treasurer be instructed to read the ordinance the first time in full. The motion was seconded by Trustee Meyer and adopted by unanimous vote. The Clerk-Treasurer then read said ordinance in full.

Trustee Berlien moved that said ordinance be advanced to second reading and be read by title only and opportunity be given for the offering of amendments. This motion was seconded by Trustee Meyer and on call of the roll adopted by the following vote:

EXHIBIT A

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE KEEPING OF HOGS OR PIGS WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF FORT BRANCH, INDIANA, AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF FORT BRANCH:

Section I

No person, firm, or corporation shall keep any hog or pig within the corporation limits of the town of Fort Branch, Indiana.

Section II

Any person, firm, or corporation violating the provisions of Section I of this ordinance shall forfeit and pay to the said Town of Fort Branch, Indiana, as a penalty for the violation thereof the sum of \$1.00 for each day for each hog or pig so kept in violation of Section I of this ordinance.

Section III

Section I

Section III

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after ^{it is passed and} notice thereof is given by posting of same in one public place in each ward of the Town of Fort Branch for the period of 10 days. Said ordinance shall be posted by the Marshall of said Town and his affidavit of the posting thereof shall be filed with the Clerk-Treasurer of said Town and spread of record on the minute book of the proceeding of the Board of Trustees of said Town and said record entry shall be sufficient *evidence* of the posting thereof as required by this ordinance.

Fred Stone being first duly sworn according to law upon his oath says that he is town Marshall of the Town of Fort Branch, Indiana, and that on the 4rd day of ~~August~~ ^{September}, 1941, he posted in a public place in each one of the three wards of said Town an ordinance duly passed and adopted by the Board of Trustees of said Town on the 4th day of ~~August~~ ^{September}, 1941.
