ADDENDUM TO ORDINANCE NO. 2018-7

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF FORT BRANCH, INDIANA AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 5:

STACY L. ELPE

The compensation for the Town Marshal of Fort Branch is fixed at a rate of no less than \$1,216.58 biweekly and not more than \$1631.58 biweekly payable by the General Fund. The compensation of the Chief Deputy Town Marshal of the Town is fixed at a rate of no less than \$1,136.14 biweekly and not more than \$1,551.14 biweekly payable by the General Fund. No additional compensation is to be paid to the Town Marshal or the First, Second, or additional Deputies under section 27 herein. Each Marshal shall work a designated shift and shall be subject to call to duty in case of an emergency. There shall be no more than seven Reserve Police Officers, who are volunteers and shall work as determined by the officer in charge. The reserve officers shall receive clothing and equipment as set out in Section 6 below, and the reserve officers shall receive no compensation. Full Time positions are salaried positions.

Shall be Amendment to and Modification of the previous Ordinance 2018-7.

THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE IN FORCE AND EFFECT beginning on the 3rd day of August, 2019.
