The President of the Board stated that a form of Ordinance regulating parking and providing penalties has been prepared and it would now be in order to consider said form of

moved that said Ordinance be numbered, placed on first reading and that the same be read in full at this time. The motion was seconded by Trustee Hacker and on call of the roll, was carried by the following vote:

1966 - 1 and having been read in full and the provisions of the

same having been considered by the Board, Trustee Blevins moved that said Ordinance be read a second time by title and that opportunity be given for the offering of amendments. This motion was seconded by Trustee McNamara and on call of the roll, was carried by the following vote:

Ordinance No. 1966 - 1 was then read a second time by title and no amendments were offered. Trustee Hacker moved that the rules be suspended and that unanimous consent be given for the adoption of Ordinance No. 1966 - 1 at this meeting without further consideration. This motion was seconded by Trustee Blevins and on call of the roll, the vote on said

motion was as follows:

a third time by title and the President announced that a
reinance was under consideration for final passage of Ordinance
