## ORDINANCE NO. 1977-

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE POSSESSION, USE OR CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES AT TOWN PROPERTY AND PROVIDING A PENALTY THEREFOR

BE IT ORDERED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF FT. BRANCH, INDIANA, as follows:

## SECTION 1. Definitions:

- (a) The term "alcoholic beverage" as used in this Ordinance means: a liquid or solid which is, or contains, alcohol and which is fit for human consumption and which is reasonably likely to, or intended, to be used as a beverage.
- (b) The term "town property" as used in this Ordinance means: any and all real estate and/or buildings owned by or predominantly used by the Town of Ft. Branch, Indiana, or any of its agencies.
- SECTION 2. It is unlawful for a person to possess, consume or otherwise use alcoholic beverages upon or in town property of the Town of Ft. Branch, Indiana.
- SECTION 3. A person who violates Section 2 of this Ordinance is guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction of the first offence shall be fined in an amount not less than Ten Dollars (\$10.00) nor more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00), to which may be added imprisonment for a period of not more than thirty (30) days. A person who is convicted of a subsequent violation of Section 2 of this Ordinance shall be fined in an amount not less than Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) nor more than Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00), to which may be added imprisonment for a period of not more than six (6) months.
- SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after publication thereof, as provided by law, and said publication is hereby ordered.
