

ORDINANCE NO. 3 OF 1978

for the

TOWN OF FORT BRANCH, INDIANA

MUNICIPAL WATER UTILITY

An ordinance fixing the schedule of rates and charges to be collected by the Town of Fort Branch, Indiana from the customers served by the Municipal Water Utility of said Town and other matters connected therewith

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees now finds that the existing rates and charges for the use of and services rendered by the waterworks of said Town are too low and are insufficient to enable the Town to properly operate its waterworks plant, provide for depreciation thereof, and that the existing rates and charges should be increased; now therefore

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF FORT BRANCH, INDIANA:

Section 1. For use of and service rendered by the waterworks system

of the Town based on the use of water supplied by said waterworks system:

(2) Metered Rates

each user shall pay a flat rate in accordance with the following applicable size or meter installed, for which the user will be entitled to the quantity of water set out in the above schedule of rates.

(C) Fire Hydrants

Municipal Hydrants = per hydrant = per month \$150.00
Private hydrants = per hydrant = per month \$150.00

(D) Tapping Fees

Each user, at the time he is connected with the waterworks system, shall pay a charge to cover the costs of capping the main, furnishing and laying service pipe, corporation and stop cocks, service and meter box and installing the meter.

The charge for 3/4 inch meter cap shall be \$150.00.
The charge for a tap larger than the 3/4" meter cap will be the cost of labor and materials.

(E) Temporary Users

Water furnished to temporary users such as contractors, circuses, etc., shall be charged on the basis of the increased gallon rates hereinbefore set forth as estimated and established by the Waterworks Superintendent.

(F) Collection and Deferred Payment Charges

All bills for water services not paid within fifteen days from the due date thereof, as stated in such bills, shall be subject to one collection or deferred payment charge of 10% on the first \$1.00 and 3% on the excess, over \$1.00.

SECTION 3. All ordinances and parts of ordinance in conflict herewith are hereby repealed; provided, however, that the standard of rates and charges fixed in this ordinance shall have become effective.

and the said bonds shall be held by the said town of Fort Branch, Indiana, and when
the passenger provided, that the schedules of rates and charges referred to
in the said bond shall become effective unless approved by the public service commission
of Indiana or until such time as said Commission may direct.
