

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE DISCHARGE
OF ANY FIREARM OR WEAPON WITHIN THE COR-
PORATE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF FT. BRANCH,
INDIANA, AND PROVIDING A PENALTY THEREFOR

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of the Town
of Ft. Branch, Indiana, as follows:

SECTION 1:

As used in this Ordinance: The term "firearm"
means any weapon which is capable of or designed
to or which may readily be converted to expel a
projectile with deadly force by means of an ex-
plosion, including but not limited to handguns,
shotguns and rifles.

SECTION 2:

It shall be unlawful for any person to discharge
any firearm projecting lead or any missile within
the corporate limits of the Town of Ft. Branch,
Indiana.

SECTION 3:

Any person convicted of violating this Ordinance
may be fined in a sum not to exceed \$1,000.00.

SECTION 4:

Nothing in this Ordinance shall be construed to
prohibit any police officer from discharging a
firearm in the performance of his duty; nor pro-
hibit any person from discharging a firearm when
lawfully defending person or property.

SECTION 5:

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect
from and after passage and publication, as by law,
required.
