

ORDINANCE NO. 1980-3

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE RUNNING
AT LARGE OF ANIMALS IN THE TOWN OF FT. BRANCH

WHEREFORE, it being determined by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Ft. Branch that all animals should be prohibited from running at large within the Town of Ft. Branch, it is ordained as follows:


SECTION 1. Animals Running at Large: No owner or keeper of any animal shall permit such animal to run at large in the Town of Ft. Branch unless the animal is in the personal custody of the owner or keeper or some individual deputized by him or her to be in charge of such animal.

SECTION 2. Penalty: The owner or keeper of any animal who permits such animal to run at large in the Town, when such animal is not in the personal custody of the owner or keeper or some individual deputized by him or her to be in charge of such animal, shall be fined not more than Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00) and costs. Each day such violation continues shall constitute a separate offense.

SECTION 3. Repealing Clause: All Ordinances, or parts thereof, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
