ORDINANCE NO. 1982-<u></u>

AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING RAILROAD STREET AS A ONE-WAY STREET AND PROVIDING A PENALTY THEREFOR

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF FORT BRANCH, INDIANA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Railroad Street located in the Town of Fort Branch, Indiana, shall be a one-way street as follows:

- (a) From Strain Street to Coal Mine Road, said Railroad Street shall be one-way south.
- (b) From John Street to State Road 168, said Railroad Street shall be one-way north.

SECTION 2: All vehicles travelling on said Railroad Street shall operate in the direction as set forth in Section 1 herein.

SECTION 3: The Town Marshall shall cause appropriate signs to be placed on said Railroad Street to designate the direction in which vehicles may be operated.

SECTION 4: Any person who violates this Ordinance shall be subject to the penalty set forth in Ordinance No. 1977-4, as amended from time to time, or as established by state law.

SECTION 5: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and its publication, as by law provided, which publication is ordered herein.
