

AN ORDINANCE MODIFYING THE METHOD FOR DETERMINATION OF CHARGES FOR THE USE AND SERVICE OF THE SEWER SYSTEM OF THE TOWN OF FORT BRANCH, INDIANA.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE Board of Trustees of the Town of Fort Branch, Indiana, as follows:

SECTION 1.: In order that residential users of the municipal sewer system of the Town of Fort Branch, Indiana should not be penalized for the sprinkling of lawns during the months of April through September, the billing for sewer service for residential users for July, August and September shall be based on the metered water usage for the previous months of January, February and March. If metered water usage for the previous months of January, February and March is greater than the metered water usage for the months of April through September then the billing for sewer services shall be computed on the actual water used for which the sewer service bill is being rendered. Residential sewer service, as applicable to the sprinkling rate, shall apply to each lot, parcel of real estate or building which is occupied and used as a residence.

SECTION 2.: Such sprinkling rates shall not apply to any premises which are partially or wholly used for industrial or commercial purposes. If a portion of such premises shall be used for commercial or industrial purposes, the owner shall have the privilege of separating the water service so that the residential portion of the premises is served through a separate meter and in such cases the water usage as registered by the water meter using such portion of the premises used for the residential purpose would qualify under the sprinkling rate.

SECTION 3.: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect on July 1, 1988.
