

ORDINANCE NO. 1991-2

An Ordinance of the Town of Fort Branch concerning the regulation of the parking of vehicles and prescribing penalties for violation thereof.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Town of Fort Branch, Indiana, as follows:


Sec. 1. No person shall stop, stand, or park a vehicle, except when necessary to avoid conflict with other traffic or to avoid conflict with law or the directions of a police officer or traffic control device, in any of the following places:

- (a) On a sidewalk;
- (b) In front of a public or private driveway;
- (c) Within an intersection;
- (d) Within fifteen feet [15'] of a fire hydrant;
- (e) On the roadway side of any vehicle stopped or parked at the edge or curb of a street;
- (f) At any place where official signs prohibit stopping.


Sec. 2. No person shall park a vehicle at any place where official signs prohibit parking.

Sec. 3. Every person who violates this Ordinance shall be fined Twenty Dollars (\$20.00).


