

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE PARKING ON  
NORTH RAILROAD STREET BETWEEN LOCUST AND VINE STREETS  
AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR VIOLATION THEREOF

WHEREAS, the Council of the Town of Fort Branch, Indiana,  
desires to regulate the parking on Railroad Street between Locust  
and Vine Streets.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Town of Fort Branch,  
Indiana, as follows:

Section 1: Parking is prohibited on Railroad Street between  
Locust and Vine Streets except for forty-five feet (45') in front  
of 112 and 114 North Railroad Street.

Section 2: Parking is permitted on Railroad Street for  
forty-five feet (45') in front of 112 and 114 North Railroad  
Street.

Section 3: Railroad Street between Locust and Vine Streets  
shall be posted with signs designating the no parking areas  
provided in this ordinance.

Section 4: Any person who violates this ordinance shall be  
fined Twenty Dollars (\$20.00).
