

AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE SCHEDULE OF RATES AND CHARGES
 TO BE COLLECTED BY THE TOWN OF FORT BRANCH, INDIANA
 FROM THE CUSTOMERS SERVED BY THE MUNICIPAL WATER
 UTILITY OF SAID TOWN

WHEREAS, The Council of the Town of Fort Branch, Indiana finds that the existing rates and charges for the use of and services rendered by the Water Works of said Town are too low and are insufficient to enable the Town to properly operate its Water Works Plant and that the existing rates should increase:

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Town of Fort Branch, Indiana as follows:

Section 1: For the use of and service rendered by the Water Works system of the Town based on the use of water supplied by said Water Works system, the following rates shall apply:

<u>(a) Metered rates per month</u>	<u>Rate per 1,000 gallons</u>
First 3,000 gallons	\$5.09
Next 2,000 gallons	\$4.49
Next 1,500 gallons	\$3.84
Next 3,500 gallons	\$3.38
Next 6,500 gallons	\$2.85
Next 15,000 gallons	\$2.35
Next 35,000 gallons	\$1.89
Over 66,500 gallons	\$1.60

<u>(b) Minimum charge</u>	<u>Rate per month</u>
3,000 gallons	\$15.27

(c) Wholesale rates to Emge Packing Company shall be as follows:

<u>Metered rates per month</u>	<u>Rate per 1,000 gallons</u>
First 5,000,000 gallons	\$2.03
Next 5,000,000 gallons	\$1.57
Over 10,000,000 gallons	\$1.07

<u>(d) Hydrant rental</u>	<u>Rate per annum</u>
Public or private hydrant- per hydrant	\$150.00

Section 2: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1992.
