

HANDICAPPED PARKING ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, the Council of the Town of Fort Branch, Indiana, desires to designate one parking space twenty (20) feet in length on the north side of Vine Street ~~between~~ in front of the Methodist Church as reserved for the use of physically handicapped persons.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Town of Fort Branch, Indiana, as follows:

Section 1: One parking space twenty (20) feet in length on the north side of Vine Street in front of the Methodist Church is designated as reserved for the use of physically handicapped persons.

Section 2: The handicapped parking space reserved by this Ordinance shall be posted with signs as provided by Indiana Code 5-16-9-2.

Section 3: Any person who parks in a space designated as a handicapped parking space in a motor vehicle, which does not have displayed a handicapped persons or disabled veterans placard or a handicapped or disabled veterans registration plate, shall be fined Twenty Dollars (\$20.00).

Section 4: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of publication as required by law.
