

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR A STOP AT THE INTERSECTION OF SOUTH VICTOR STREET AND WEST RED BANK ROAD IN THE TOWN OF FORT BRANCH, INDIANA

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Town of Fort Branch, Indiana as follows:

Section 1: Section 3 of Ordinance No. 1977-4 of the Town of Ft. Branch, Indiana, entitled "An Ordinance Regulating Traffic in The Town of Ft. Branch, Indiana And Providing A Penalty For Its Violation" is hereby amended by adding the following additional provisions:

The intersection of South Victor Street and West Red Bank Road within the Town of Ft. Branch, Indiana, is hereby designated as a stop intersection for vehicles proceeding south on South Victor Street. Drivers of vehicles proceeding south on South Victor Street shall first come to a complete stop before entering said intersection and shall not proceed into said intersection until they have first yielded the right-of-way to the driver of any other vehicle proceeding east or west on West Red Bank Road. The intersection shall be posted with stop signs in accordance with the law.

Section 2: All other provisions of Ordinance No. 1977-4 shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 3: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as by law required.
