ORDINANCE NO. 1994-6

AN ANIMAL CONTROL ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, a problem exists in the Town of Fort Branch from dogs' defecating on public and private property, and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Fort Branch desires to enact an ordinance to rectify the problem caused by dogs' defecating on public and private property,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Town of Fort Branch, Indiana, as follows:

Section 1: The owner of every animal, except guide dogs, shall be responsible for the immediate removal of any excrement deposited by his or her animal on public property or on the private property of others. A guide dog shall mean any animal serving a blind or deaf person in an auxiliary capacity.

Section 2: Any person violating any provision of this Ordinance shall be deemed guilty of an offense and shall be punished by a fine of \$25.00.

Section 3: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as by law required.
