ORDINANCE NO. 1997-2

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR A STOP AT THE RAILROAD CROSSING OF JOHN STREET AND THE CSX RAILROAD TRACKS

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Town of Fort Branch,
Indiana as follows:

Section 1: Section 3 of Ordinance No. 1977-4 of the Town of Ft. Branch, Indiana, entitled "An Ordinance Regulating Traffic in The Town of Ft. Branch, Indiana And Providing A Penalty For Its Violation" is hereby amended by adding the following additional provisions:

The railroad crossing of John Street and the CSX Railroad tracks is hereby designated as stop for vehicles traveling on John Street. Drivers of vehicles traveling on John Street shall first come to a complete stop before crossing the tracks and shall proceed only upon exercising due care. The intersection shall be posted with stop signs in accordance with the law, provided however that the stop signs shall not be within the ballast line adjacent to the rails.

Section 2: All other provisions of Ordinance No. 1977-4 shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 3: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as by law required.
