

ORDINANCE NO. 1998-4

**AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR A STOP AT THE INTERSECTIONS OF
FOSTER STREET WITH WALTERS AND LINCOLN STREETS**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Town of Fort Branch,
Indiana as follows:

Section 1: Section 3 of Ordinance No. 1977-4 of the Town of
Ft. Branch, Indiana, entitled "An Ordinance Regulating Traffic in
The Town of Ft. Branch, Indiana And Providing A Penalty For Its
Violation" is hereby amended by adding the following additional
provisions:

The intersections of Foster Street with Walters and Lincoln
Streets within the Town of Ft. Branch, Indiana, are hereby
designated as stop intersections for vehicles traveling on
Foster Street. Drivers of vehicles traveling on Foster
Street shall first come to a complete stop before entering
onto Walters Street and before entering onto Lincoln
Street and shall not proceed into said intersections until
they have first yielded the right-of-way to the driver of
any other vehicle traveling on Walters Street and Lincoln
Street. The intersections shall be posted with stop signs
in accordance with the law.


Section 2: All other provisions of Ordinance No. 1977-4
shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 3: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect
from and after its passage and publication as by law required.
