ORDINANCE NO. 1998-5

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE PARKING ON FOSTER STREET BETWEEN WALTERS AND LINCOLN STREETS AND PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY FOR VIOLATION

WHEREAS, the Council of the Town of Fort Branch, Indiana, desires to regulate the parking on the Foster Street between Walters and Lincoln Streets.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Town of Fort Branch, Indiana, as follows:

<u>Section 1:</u> Parking is prohibited on both sides of Foster Street between Walters and Lincoln Streets.

<u>Section 2:</u> Both sides of Foster Street between Walters and Lincoln Streets shall be posted with signs designating no parking as provided in this ordinance.

Section 3: Any person who violates this ordinance shall be
fined Twenty Dollars (\$20.00).

Section 4: This ordinance shall be effective from and after the date of passage and when published as by law required.
