

ORDINANCE NO. 1999-2

**AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE PARKING ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF  
POPLAR STREET BETWEEN MAIN STREET AND RAILROAD STREET AND  
PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY FOR VIOLATION**

WHEREAS, the Council of the Town of Fort Branch, Indiana, desires to regulate the parking on the South side of Poplar Street between Main Street and Railroad Street.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Town of Fort Branch, Indiana, as follows:

Section 1: Parking is prohibited on the South side of Poplar Street between Main Street and Railroad Street.

Section 2: The South side of Poplar Street between Main Street and Railroad Street shall be posted with signs designating no parking as provided in this ordinance.

Section 3: Any person who violates this ordinance shall be fined Twenty Dollars (\$20.00).

Section 4: This ordinance shall be effective from and after the date of passage and when published as by law required.
