

ORDINANCE NO. 1999-9

**AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR A FOUR-WAY STOP AT WALNUT AND ELM STREETS**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Town of Fort Branch, Indiana as follows:

Section 1: Section 3 of Ordinance No. 1977-4, as amended, of the Town of Ft. Branch, Indiana, entitled "An Ordinance Regulating Traffic in The Town of Ft. Branch, Indiana and Providing A Penalty For Its Violation" is hereby amended by adding the following additional provisions:

The intersection of Walnut Street and Elm Street within the Town of Ft. Branch, Indiana is hereby designated as a stop intersection for vehicles proceeding east and west on Walnut Street and north and south on Elm Street. Drivers of vehicles proceeding east and west on Walnut Street and north and south on Elm Street shall first come to a complete stop before entering said intersection. The intersection shall be posted with stop signs in accordance with the law.

Section 2: All other provisions of Ordinance No. 1977-4, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 3: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as by law required.
