

ORDINANCE NO. 2000-6

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING SPEED LIMITS FOR CERTAIN STREETS

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Fort Branch, Indiana determines that the maximum reasonable and safe speed for the following streets is 30 miles per hour:

1. N. West Street between Vine Street and Highway 168.
2. N. Main Street between Williams Street and Highway 168.
3. Oak Street between Lincoln Street and Hillcrest Street.
4. Locust Street Between Main Street and U.S. Highway 41.

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Fort Branch, Indiana determines that the maximum reasonable and safe speed for Strain Street between Main Street and Lincoln Street is 20 miles per hour.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Town of Fort Branch, Indiana, as follows:

ARTICLE I.

A person may not drive a vehicle on the following streets in the Town of Fort Branch, Indiana, in excess of thirty (30) miles per hour:

1. N. West Street between Vine Street and Highway 168.
2. N. Main Street between Williams Street and Highway 168.
3. Oak Street between Lincoln Street and Hillcrest Street.
4. Locust Street Between Main Street and U.S. Highway 41.

ARTICLE II.

A person may not drive a vehicle on Strain Street between Main Street and Lincoln Street in the Town of Fort Branch, Indiana, in excess of twenty (20) miles per hour.

ARTICLE III.

The speed limit on the above stated streets shall be posted as required by law.

ARTICLE IV.

A person who violates this ordinance commits a Class C infraction punishable with a fine as established by state law.

ARTICLE V.

This Ordinance shall be in effect from and after its publication as by law required.
