

HANDICAPPED PARKING ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, the Council of the Town of Fort Branch, Indiana, desires to designate one parking space on the east side of McCreary Street in front of the Freedom Hall as reserved for the use of physically handicapped persons and two parking spaces at the north end of the Town Parking Lot near the intersection of McCreary Street and Vine Street as reserved for the use of physically handicapped persons.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Town of Fort Branch, Indiana, as follows:

Section 1: One parking space on the east side of McCreary Street in front of Freedom Hall be and hereby is designated as reserved for the use of physically handicapped persons.

Section 2: Two parking spaces at the north end of the Town Parking Lot near the intersection of McCreary Street and Vine Street be and hereby are designated as reserved for the use of physically handicapped persons.

Section 3: The handicapped parking spaces reserved by this Ordinance shall be posted with signs and marked as provided by Indiana Code 5-16-9-2.

Section 4: Any person who parks in a space designated as a handicapped parking space in a motor vehicle, which does not have displayed a handicapped persons or disabled veterans placard or a handicapped or disabled veterans registration plate, shall be fined Twenty Dollars (\$20.00).

Section 5: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of publication as required by law.
