Section 1: Section 3 of Ordinance No. 1977-4 of the Town of Ft. Branch, Indiana, entitled "An Ordinance Regulating Traffic in The Town of Ft. Branch, Indiana And Providing A Penalty For Its Violation," as amended, is hereby amended by adding the following additional provisions:

McCreary Street at the intersection of Williams Street within the Town of Ft. Branch, Indiana, is no longer designated as a stop intersection for vehicles traveling North and South on McCreary Street and the stop signs on McCreary Street at the intersection of Williams Street shall be eliminated. John Street at the intersection with the railroad tracks within the Town of Ft. Branch, Indiana, is no longer designated as a stop intersection for vehicles traveling East and West on John Street and the stop signs on John Street at the railroad tracks shall be eliminated. The stop signs posted at said intersections shall be removed in accordance with this ordinance.

Section 2: All other provisions of Ordinance No. 1977-4, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 3: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
