ORDINANCE NO. 2004 - 2

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2003-5

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF FORT BRANCH, INDIANA, AS FOLLOWS:

ARTICLE I

Section 6 (B) and Section 6 (E) of Ordinance No. 2003-5 of the Town of Fort Branch, Indiana, entitled, "An Ordinance of the Town of Fort Branch, Indiana fixing the Compensation for Elected Officials and all appointed employees of the Town of Fort Branch, Water and Sewer Departments for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 2004, and ending December 31, 2004."

Section 6 (B) shall be amended to read as follows:

SECTION 6 (B): Said wages payable from Motor Vehicle Highway, Water and Sewer Departments. Said compensation to be paid bi-weekly (from Thursday to Thursday). For the purpose of this section a full time worker shall be a worker engaged in an average of forty (40) hours per week or more and a worker who is hired with the anticipation that said worker will remain an employee of the Town indefinitely. The Town Council of the Town of Fort Branch shall designate which class an employee will be paid from and also what department shall pay them.

SECTION 6 (E): The Group Leader or General Maintenance, Sewer, Street, Water and Park Supervisor compensation is fixed at \$29,000.00 per year. Said compensation to be paid from Motor Vehicle Highway Fund, Water Department, Sewer Department and Park Department. Said compensation shall be paid bi-weekly. The Group Leader's hours shall be set at 40 hours per week with compensatory time for all hours over 40 hours per week.

SECTION 7 and SECTION 10:

Delete: "These compensations are to be paid semi-monthly".

Amended: "These compensations are to be paid bi-weekly."

ARTICLE II

All other provisions of Ordinance No. 2003-5 shall remain in full force and effect.
