## ordinance no. 2005 - <u>/3</u>

## AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR TWO-WAY VEHICLE TRAFFIC ON RAILROAD STREET BETWEEN LOCUST STREET AND VINE STREET

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF FORT BRANCH, INDIANA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Railroad Street between Locust Street and Vine Street is hereby designated as a two (2) way street for vehicles traveling north and south on Railroad Street.

SECTION 2: The intersection of Railroad Street and Locust Street is hereby designated as a stop intersection for vehicles traveling south on Railroad Street. Drivers of vehicles traveling on Railroad Street shall first come to a complete stop at the intersection of Locust Street and yield right of way to all traffic on Locust Street.

SECTION 3: The intersection of Railroad Street and Vine Street is hereby designated as a stop intersection for vehicles traveling north on Railroad Street. Drivers of vehicles traveling on Railroad Street shall first come to a complete stop at the intersection of Vine Street and yield right of way to all traffic on Vine Street.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as by law required.
