

ORDINANCE NO. 2005 - 2

AMENDMENT TO THE ORDINANCE
ESTABLISHING AN ACCIDENT REPORT
FUND AND VEHICLE IDENTIFICATION FUND

WHEREAS, Indiana Code 9-1-2-1 and 9-3-1-3 have been repealed.

WHEREAS, Indiana Code 9-26-2-3, 9-29-11-1 and 9-29-4-2 have been reacted to replace 9-1-2-1

and 9-3-1-3;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF FORT BRANCH, INDIANA, as follows:

SECTION 1: As by Indiana Statute provided, Town of Fort Branch, Gibson County, Indiana, shall be allowed to collect a fee of Five Dollars (\$5.00) for each accident report requested by each person, firm, entity, or corporation. Said funds shall be deposited in the Continuing Marshal's Education Fund.

SECTION 2: The monies collected and deposited into the Accident Report Fund may be spent by the Town Marshal with approval from the Town Council.

SECTION 3: As by Indiana Statute provided, Town of Fort Branch, Gibson County, Indiana, shall establish a Vehicle Identification Fund which allows the Town Marshal to collect a fee of Five Dollars (\$5.00) for providing the service to each inspection for each person, firm, entity or corporation as defined by I.C. 9-17-2-12. Said funds shall be deposited in the Marshal's Continuing Education Fund.

SECTION 4: The monies collected and deposited into the Vehicle Inspection Fund may be spent by the Town Marshal with approval from the Town Council.

SECTION 5: Town of Fort Branch, Gibson County, Indiana, shall establish a photograph and VHS Tape Fund which allows the Town Marshal to collect a fee of Three Dollars (\$3.00) per VHS tape or photograph as requested by each person, firm, entity or corporation. Said funds shall be deposited in the Marshal's Continuing Education Fund.

SECTION 6: The monies collected and deposited into the Photograph and VHS Tape Fund may be spent by the Town Marshal with approval from the Town Council.

SECTION 7: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon and after its passage. 1-19-05
