ORDINANCE NO. 2008- 9

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR A FOUR-WAY STOP AT WILLARD AND MULBERRY STREETS

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Town of Fort Branch, Indiana, as follows:

Section 1: Section 3 of Ordinance No. 1977-4, as amended of the Town of Ft. Branch, Indiana, entitled "An Ordinance Regulating Traffic in The Town of Ft. Branch, Indiana, and Providing a Penalty for its Violation" is hereby amended by adding the following additional provisions:

The intersection of Willard Street and Mulberry Street within the Town of Ft. Branch, Indiana, is hereby designated as a stop intersection for vehicles proceeding east and west on Mulberry Street and north and south on Willard Street. Drivers of vehicles proceeding east and west on Mulberry Street and north and south on Willard Street shall first come to a complete stop before entering said intersection. The intersection shall be posted with stop signs in accordance with law.

Section 2: All other provisions of Ordinance No. 1977-4 shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 3: Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as by law required.
